Preparation of an accessibility declaration

The **exact address (URL)** of the webpage containing inaccessible content or elements, A **description of the problem** and a suggestion on how to resolve it in a way that best suits the requester's needs.

If an alternative means of access is requested, the preferred format should also be specified (e.g., reading a document aloud, describing video content, etc.).

We will respond to your request as soon as possible, but no later than **7 days** from the date of receipt. If we are unable to meet this deadline, we will inform you and set a new one, which will not exceed **2 months**.

If ensuring digital accessibility is not possible, the public entity will propose an **alternative means of access** to the information.

If the request for accessibility or alternative access is denied, you may file a **complaint** concerning the accessibility of the website, mobile application, or their elements.

After exhausting the above procedure, you may also submit a complaint to the Commissioner for Human Rights (Rzecznik Praw Obywatelskich).
